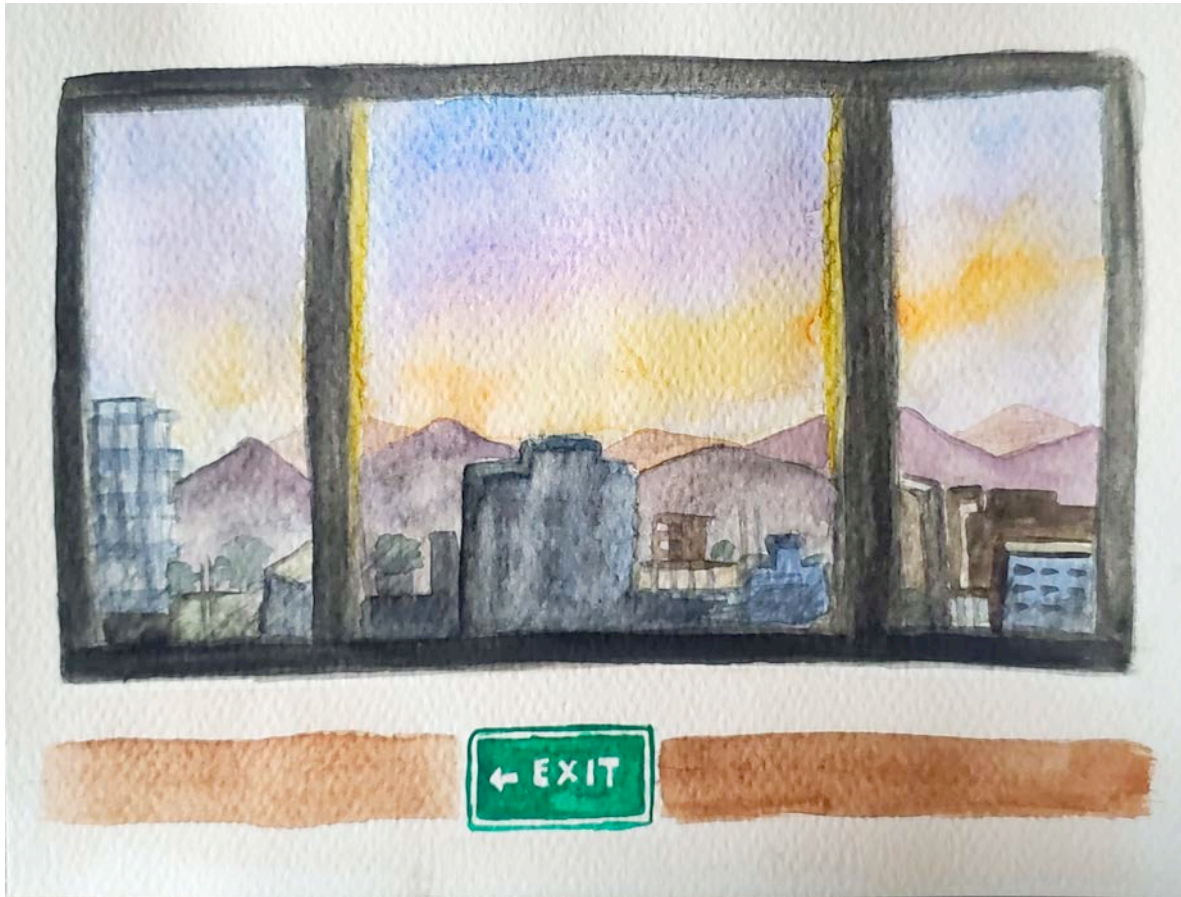


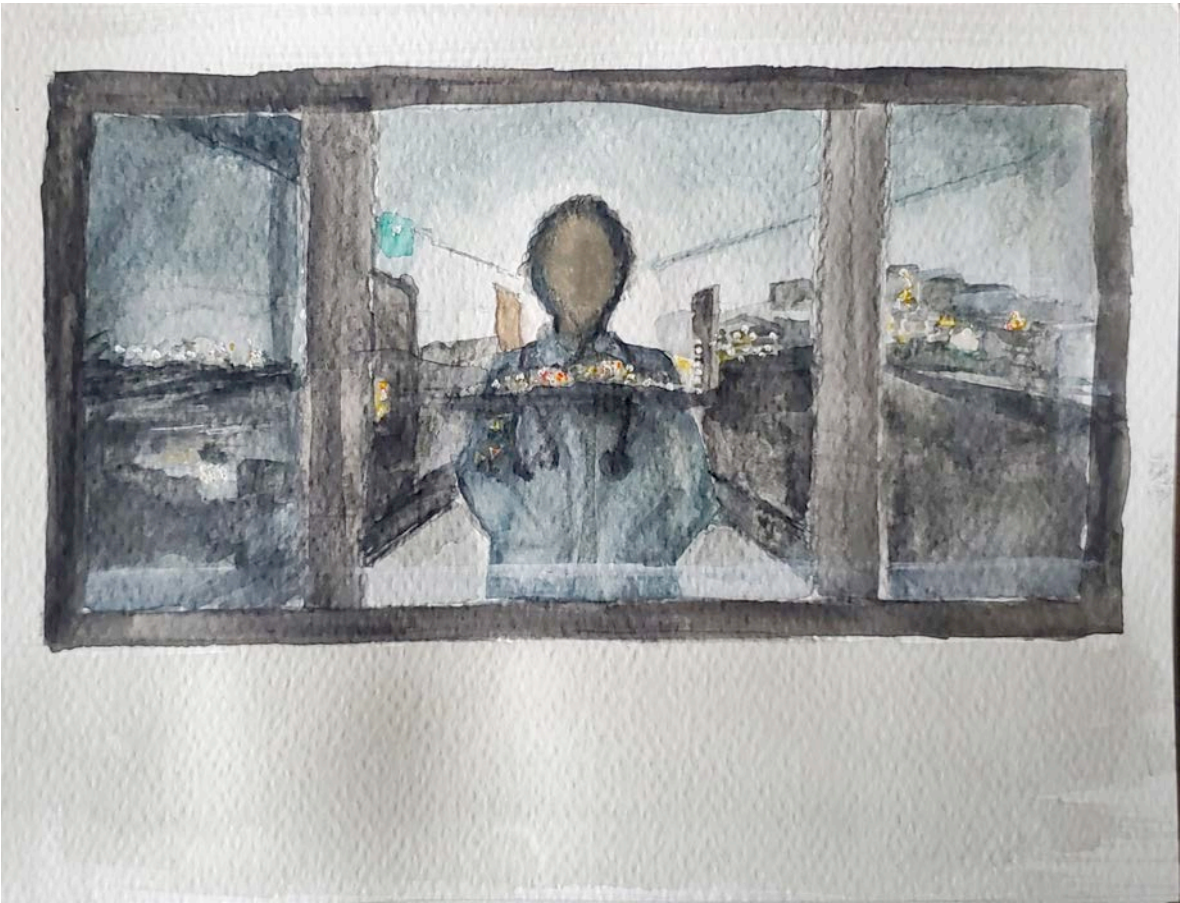
Inside Looking Out
