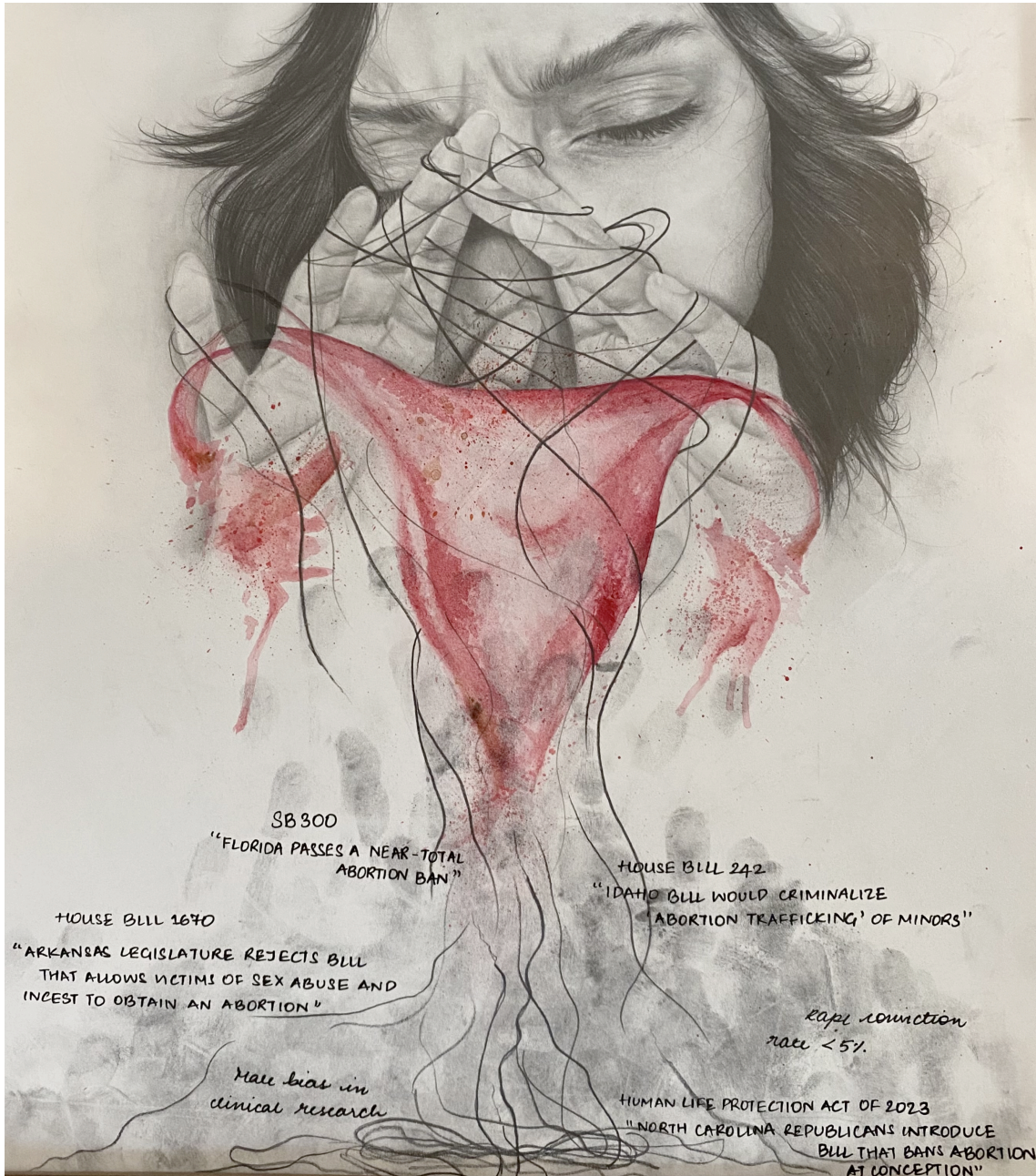


# My Voice. My Fight. My Freedom
